Dear Parishioners,

On today's insert you will find the 2015 Statement of Financial Activity for Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish. Usually this Report is published earlier in the year but has been delayed due to the significant Parish

Golden Jubilee preparations and celebrations that have consumed a lot of our time and energy. I thank you for your understanding in this matter.

Generally speaking the year of 2015 was an outstanding year. I would call it a miraculous year. Thanks to the generosity of our long time parishioner Alice Salvado who passed away on November 1, 2014, we were able to pay off the remaining debt balance on the parish hall. The remaining portion from the Salvado Trust has been deposited into a Diocesan savings account which is secured and restricted only for future capital improvements to the church building.

Being relieved from the financial burden of our parish debt we were able to look beyond our parish needs and with a generous heart we supported the Diocesan Capital Campaign. Thanks to the generosity of more than 80 donors, our parish was not only able to meet our goal but also to exceed it. I believe that with God's help we will fulfill our pledge obligations. Remember, our parish will receive 25% back from the Campaign.

In the near future we are planning to implement some necessary capital improvements to the church building. Using some of the available space in the former church kitchen, we plan on installing a crying room for parents with small children along with a permanent confessional. We will do necessary improvements to our stained glass windows and replace all the doors. We will start planning to remodel our sanctuary and build a shrine to the Blessed Mother and The Divine Mercy. Finally we will remodel our church ceiling and install new lights and a new sound system.

Looking forward, let's not forget our regular Sunday collections to ensure that they are sufficient to cover day to day operating expenses and improve our parish ministries.

I am confident that with the help of the Parish Standing Committees, and using the 2016 budget as a guideline, we will continue to allocate our resources in a most effective manner. I know that God will continue to bless this Parish through you, as I have witnessed many times.

May the Blessed Mother Mary, Our Lady of Good Counsel, always intercede for us and for our families!

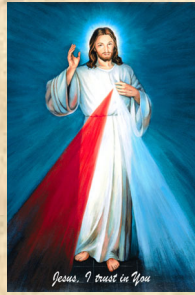

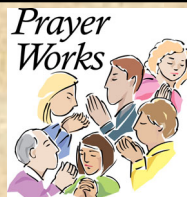
