The Catholic Voice, like the Diocese of Oakland, was born 54 years ago.

The first bishop of Oakland, Floyd L. Begin sought to create "a vehicle of apostolic and adult education to help preserve the faith in a troubled world ... a communication tool, an adult education program, a vehicle to inform, educate and speak to Catholics within the diocese."

For 54 years now, *The Voice* has tried to fulfill that mission. Despite some growing pains, *The Voice* has grown into one of the nation's biggest Catholic newspapers.

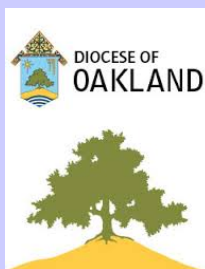
For many years, *The Voice* was printed only in black ink. It added a few pages of color photos in the late 1990s and became an all-color newspaper two years ago.

Initially a weekly newspaper, rising postage and production costs saw it cut to an every other week publication in 1986. For about a decade now, it publishes 21 issues a year. A paperback edition is delivered to all parishes.

Next weekend, October 15-16, our second collection will be totally dedicated to *The Catholic Voice*. Special envelopes are inserted in today's bulletin for your convenience. The donations collected for *The Catholic Voice* will remain in our parish to offset our parish support for *The Voice* and affiliated operations. Please make your check payable to **OLGC** with "*The Catholic Voice*" on the memo line.

Every registered Catholic household is entitled to receive *The Voice* as part of belonging to a parish. It is the bishop's primary method of communicating with the people, and the primary method people of the diocese know about each other and their Catholic faith.
