WIS 18:6-9; PS 33; HEB 11:1-2, 8-19 or 11:1-2, 8-12; LK 12:32-48 or 12:35-40

Once again Jesus shocked his listeners, and he continues to shock us today: *“Sell your belongings and give alms.”* That sounds reckless and goes against all we have heard about financial planning.

But then Jesus goes on to talk about real wealth, *“Provide money bags for yourselves that do not wear out, an inexhaustible treasure in heaven that no thief can reach nor moth destroy”* And because it is in heaven, we don’t have to worry about leaving it to someone who might spend it foolishly (*Ecclesiastes 2:21*) or worry that God will prevent us from keeping it all for ourselves (*Luke 12:16-21*).

That seems all nonsense, of course, to those who assume that the only thing that is wealth is what can be measured in dollars and cents, preferably in one’s own bank account. But sound Christian doctrine teaches us that what really matters are faith, hope, and charity, resulting in joy and peace.

Whether our goal is worldly wealth or heavenly riches, really depends on how much we trust God. As the Psalmist sings, *“Our soul waits for the Lord, who is our help and our shield.”*

The model of faithful living, according to Hebrews, is the Old Testament patriarch Abraham. Willing to risk all for the sake of obeying God, he left his home for an unknown country – when he was 75 years old. That is not claiming to trust God – that’s demonstrating your trust by your actions.

Likewise, we’re invited to live out our faith in God by generously sharing what he has entrusted to us. We do not need to fear when God has promised us a place in his Kingdom. And that’s where our real treasure, what we really value, should be stored. As Jesus teaches, *“For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be.”*


The Statue will leave at 3:30 PM
