Praying for our Beloved Faithful Departed

The upcoming month of November is a special time when we remember our beloved faithful departed. We begin the month by celebrating the saints — those who are definitively in heaven, the canonized and un-canonized — and by invoking their intercession as we continue on our pilgrimage of faith in this world. But then we immediately turn in suffrage for all those who have died and are longing to share in the communion of the saints but who are not yet experiencing their joy.

We pray for the dead because we know in faith three truths: first, contrary to the popular opinion that presumes that everyone who dies goes to a “better place,” the Catholic faith does not believe everyone who dies goes to heaven, especially immediately; second, the dead may need our help; and third, our prayers, especially Holy Masses offered for them can in fact help them a lot. Mass as a “*Source and summit*” of the Christian life and a perfect prayer offered for our beloved faithful departed may help hasten their final purification which they may still be undergoing in purgatory.

Beginning **next Saturday, November 2nd (All Souls Day)** through **Sunday, November 9th**, we are going to celebrate a Novena of Masses for the souls of our beloved departed. We will ask our gracious God to grant them forgiveness for their sins and reward their good deeds with everlasting peace and happiness. You can bring the picture of your loved ones who have died and they will be placed on a special display in the church.

Last weekend we enclosed in our parish bulletin a special form where you may put the names of your loved ones who have already left this world. Please return this form by mailing it using the same original window envelope, dropping it in the collection basket or bringing it to the parish office. You may also use extra forms available on the table at the back of the church and in the vestibule. Your deceased loved ones will be included in Novena Masses and their names will be entered in the Book of Remembrance. The book will be placed on the altar during the Novena Masses. The dates and times of Masses are as follows:

November 2nd (All Souls Day – Saturday) at 8:00am & 5:00pm, **November 3rd (Sunday)** at 8:30am & 11:00am, **November 4th (Monday)** at 9:00am, **November 5th (Tuesday)** at 9:00am, **November 6th (Wednesday)** at 9:00am, **November 7th (Thursday)** at 9:00am, **November 9th (Friday)** at 9:00am, **November 10th (Sunday)** at 8:30am & 11:00am.

Q. Why does the Catholic Church discourage Bible reading when, according to the Apostle, "All scripture, inspired of God, is profitable to teach...[and] to instruct in justice"? (2 Tim. 3:16).



**Catholic
Answers**

A If the Catholic Church discourages Bible reading, the Pope, the thousands of Catholic Bishops, and the many millions of Catholic lay people, are not aware of it. For the Popes have issued pastoral letters to the whole Church, called encyclicals, on the edifying effects of Bible reading. The Catholic Bible far outsells all other Christian Bibles worldwide. In fact, it has always been thus. The very first Christian Bible was produced by the Catholic Church -- compiled by Catholic scholars of the 2nd and 3rd century and approved for general Christian use by the Catholic Councils of Hippo (393) and Carthage (397). The very first printed Bible was produced under the auspices of the Catholic Church -- printed by the Catholic inventor of the printing press, Johannes Gutenberg. And the very first Bible with chapters and numbered verses was produced by the Catholic Church -- the work of Stephen Langton, Cardinal Archbishop of Canterbury. It was this perennial Catholic devotion to the Bible which prompted Martin Luther -- who certainly cannot be accused of Catholic favoritism -- to write in his *Commentary on St. John*: "We are compelled to concede to the Papists that they have the Word of God, that we received it from them, and that without them we should have no knowledge of it at all."
